Categories of housing systems for laying hens

Introduction

Council Directive 1999/74/EC laying down minimum standards for housing of laying hens, defines three major categories of housing system: alternative systems, unenriched cage systems and enriched cage systems. In time unenriched cages are due to be phased out, leaving only two categories of housing system. Both categories however comprise a wide variety of different models, making it hard to draw conclusions on bird welfare in these systems. A better indication of welfare in relation to housing system can be made by using sub-categories of housing system.
